Free Crochet Pattern



Sheep

in Robin Fleece Chunky, Robin DK and Robin Super Chunky

Suitable for any Wendy or Robin Chunky, Aran and Super Chunky, yarn amounts may vary

Materials and Measurements

Sheep	Large	Extra Large	
Height approx	28	33	cm
	11	13	ins
Robin Fleece Chunky 100g	3	10	balls
Robin DK 100g	1	1	ball
Robin Super Chunky 100g	2	4	balls
1 - 15.00mm (UK19 - USP/Q19) crochet hook. Craft Filling.

IMPORTANT

Use only the Robin yarns specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect project if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch - chain; **dc** - double crochet; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **ins** - inches; **cm** - centimetres; **ss** - slip stitch; **tog** - together.

TENSION

Tension is not important for these designs.

LARGE SHEEP

Note:- Body uses 8 strands of yarn.

5 strands of Robin Fleece Chunky and 3 strands of Robin DK. Arms and Legs use 3 strands of Robin Super Chunky. Before you start

wind off some of the yarn to make the required number of strands.

BODY

Using 15.00mm hook and 8 strands of Cream (5 of Chunky and 3 DK).

1st round - Ch 2, 6dc into 1st ch. 6 sts.

2nd round - 2dc into each st 6 times. 12 sts.

3rd round - [2dc into next st, 1dc into next st] 6 times. 18 sts.

4th to 9th rounds - 1dc in each st around. 18 sts.

10th round - [dc2tog, 1dc] 6 times. 12 sts.

11th round - 1dc in each st around. 12 sts.
Stuff.

12th round - [dc2tog] 4 times, 2dc, dc2tog, turn.

13th round - Ch 1, [dc2tog] 2 times, turn.

14th round - Ch 1, 2dc, turn.

15th round - Ch 1, 2dc, turn.

16th round - Ch 1, 2dc turn.
Fasten off.

HEAD

Using 15.00mm hook and 3 strands of Super Chunky.

1st round - Ch 2, 6dc into 1st ch. 6 sts.

2nd round - [2dc into each st] 6 times. 12 sts.

3rd to 6th rounds - 1dc in each st around. 12 sts.

5th round - [dc2tog] 6 times. 6 sts.
Stuff.

6th round - 1dc in each st around. 6 sts.

Do not break yarn.

EARS

7th row - Ch 8, squash head flat at the top, 3dc working into front and back rows at the same time, ch 8, ss into base of 8ch just worked.

Fasten off.

LEGS (make 2)

Using 15.00mm hook and 3 strands of Super Chunky.

1st round - Ch 2, 6dc into 1st ch. 6 sts.

2nd round [2dc into next st, 1dc] 3 times. 9 sts.

3rd round - [dc2tog, 1dc] 3 times. 6 sts.

4th round - [dc2tog] 3 times. 3 sts.

5th round - dc3tog.

Work 8 ch and fasten off.

ARMS (make 2)

Work as given for legs from 1st to 5th rounds.

Work 6 ch and fasten off.

MAKING UP

Embroider eyes, nose and mouth detail onto your sheep's head if desired. Sew head in place by folding the top rows of the body over the top of your sheep's head. Sew arms and legs in place.

EXTRA LARGE SHEEP

Note:- Body uses 11 strands of yarn. 8 strands of Robin Fleece Chunky and 3 strands Robin DK. Arms and Legs use 5 strands of Robin Super Chunky. You will need to wind off some of the yarn to make the required number of strands. For the Body we suggest you use 8 full balls of Robin Fleece Chunky to start with

and then divide the yarn from the remaining 2 balls of Chunky into 8 smaller balls of 25g each. The 100g DK ball will need to be divided into 3.

BODY

Using 15.00mm hook and 11 strands of Cream (8 of Chunky and 3 of DK).

1st round - Ch 2, 6dc into 1st ch. 6 sts.

2nd round - 2dc into each st 6 times. 12 sts.

3rd round - [2dc into next st, 1dc into next st] 6 times. 18 sts.

4th round - [2dc into next st, 1dc into next 2 sts] 6 times. 24 sts.

5th round - [2dc into next st, 1dc into next 3 sts] 6 times. 30 sts.

6th to 13th rounds - 1dc in each st around. 30 sts.

14th round - [dc2tog, 1dc into next 3 sts] 6 times. 24 sts.

15th round - [dc2tog, 1dc into next 2 sts] 6 times. 18 sts.

16th round - [dc2tog, 1dc into next st] 6 times. 12 sts.

17th round - 1dc in each st around. 12 sts.

Stuff.

18th round [dc2tog] 4 times, 2dc, dc2tog, turn.

19th round - Ch 1, [dc2tog] 2 times, turn.

20th round - Ch 1, 2dc, turn.

21st round - Ch 1, 2dc, turn.

22nd round - Ch 1, 2dc turn. Fasten off.

HEAD AND EARS

Work as given for Head of large sheep but using 5 strands of Robin Super Chunky.

LEGS AND ARMS

Work as given for Legs and Arms of large sheep but using 5 strands of Robin Super Chunky.

MAKING UP

Work as given for large sheep.



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
